

4) Selection Procedure

A) For Post of Trainee Junior Officer

1. The selection of candidates will be on the basis of On-line Examination and personal interview.

2. Pattern of the On-line written test /Examination will be as under:

3. The On-line Examination will be only in English language.

4. Candidates have to score minimum 50% i.e. 100 marks as cut-off marks for being shortlisted for Personal interview for the post of Trainee Junior Officer. The Bank has the right to increase or decrease the cut-off marks criteria.

5. Candidates will be shortlisted for personal interview based on their performance in On-line Examination, validation of Education Qualifications and experience based upon the documents submitted.

6. **Merit List:** Selection list will be prepared in descending order on the basis of scores obtained in On-line Examination and Interview.

B) For Post of Trainee Associates

1. Preliminary examination is qualifying in nature. The final selection of candidates will be on the basis of Mains Examination.

2. Pattern of the Preliminary & Mains Examination will be as under:

The marks obtained in the Online preliminary examination will be reckoned for shortlisting for Main examination. Depending upon the number of vacancies, only those candidates who rank sufficiently high in the online preliminary exam will be called for Main examination in the ratio of as decided by the bank.

3. The Preliminary & Mains Examination will be only in English language.
4. Candidates have to score minimum 50% i.e. 50 marks as cut-off marks in the Preliminary Examination for being shortlisted for Mains Examination for the post of Trainee Associates.
5. Candidates have to score minimum 50% i.e. 100 marks as cut-off marks in the Mains Examination.
6. **Merit List:** Merit list of first 200 candidates (i.e. 4 times the no. of vacancies) will be prepared in descending order on the basis of scores obtained in the On-line Mains Examination. The said merit list will be valid for 12 months.

5) Examination Centre

1. a) For the Post of Trainee Junior Officer :

The On-line Examination will be held at **Mumbai, Pune, Nagpur, Nasik, Aurangabad, Nanded and Kolhapur** Centres. MSC Bank reserves the right to allot any other Centre to the candidate. Personal Interview will be held at Mumbai.

b) For the Post of Trainee Associate:

The On-line Preliminary Examination will be held at **Mumbai, Pune, Nagpur, Nasik, Aurangabad, Nanded and Kolhapur** Centres. MSC Bank reserves the right to allot any other Centre to the candidate. Online Mains Examination will be held at Mumbai.
